## **HOSTING THE AHA DISTANCE HORSE NATIONALS**

With 3 glorious days of riding in the breathtaking mountains of the beautiful Boise Basin, where gold was discovered in 1862, and beautiful treasures are still found today.

Day 1 – Friday August 29th, AHA 50 mile, Open 50 and 25 mile endurance rides
Day 2 – Saturday August 30<sup>th</sup>, CTR, Open 50 and 25 mile endurance rides
Day 3 – Sunday August 31st, AHA 100 mile, Open 75, 50 and 25 mile endurance rides

Introductory rides will be available all 3 days.

<u>Directions:</u> From I-84 in Boise take Hwy 21 NE 36 miles to Idaho City. Turn Left (north) onto Montgomery St. At the end of the street, turn left (west) and continue for 7 miles (dirt road between towns) to Centerville. Turn right (north) onto Henry's creek Rd. and continue approx. ½ mile into camp.

<u>Camp:</u> Ride camp is located on private property, but borders Forest Service land so **weed free hay is required.** Horse water will be supplied but bring people water. Dogs are always welcome but must be leashed at all times. GPS Coordinates: Latitude: 43.88627 Longitude: -115.90513

<u>Registration and Fees:</u> Watch our Webpage, Facebook, and the AERC Ride calendar for updated Fee information as the event nears. Non-AERC members will be subject to an additional \$20 per day non-member fee for competitive distances.

## JUNIORS (under age 18 as of 1/1/25) ride open rides for FREE

<u>Start Times:</u> 50 and 55 mile rides @ 7:00am; LDs & CTR @ 7:30am, 100 milers @ 5:30. Intro ride any time after 9am but no later than 3pm (Intro riders must check in & out with ride management and see the vets). Check-in and Vetting to start approx. 4pm on Thursday Aug 29<sup>th</sup> for Friday riders.

<u>Trails:</u> Trails are primarily old logging roads, ATV and single-track trials on private property, US Forest Service and Idaho State Lands. The terrain is mostly nice, sound footing with sandy surfaces, but there are water crossings and rocky sections through dredged creek banks. **Hoof Protection is <u>STRONGLY</u> recommended** for all horses.

**Meetings:** Registration starts approx. 4pm on Thursday. Pre-ride meeting each night at approx. 7pm.
