

Heather Bradshaw Memorial Endurance Ride

Saturday September 13, 2025

50 mile (EC/AERC), 25 mile (ERABC), ~12 mile Fun Ride.

Come join us in the sunny Okanagan of British Columbia for the Heather Bradshaw Memorial Ride!

Base camp is located at the Summerland Rodeo Grounds in Summerland, BC. Summerland is located between the cities of Kelowna and Penticton, a l hour drive north of the Canada-US border (Osoyoos/Oroville). See enduranceridersassocofbc.wildapricot.org/events for details and directions.

Camping – Corrals are first come first serve. \$10/rig/night. Washrooms on site. No fires permitted!

Water – Horse water is available from a tap on the grounds. Please bring your own drinking water to the ride site. Potable water may be available but is not guaranteed.

Trails. Trails will be a mixture of KVR/Trans Canada, quad trails, and single track. The KVR is smooth but hard gravel, remainder is mostly sandy footing with some rocky sections. Hoof protection is strongly recommended.

Weather could range from very hot (90 degrees Fahrenheit/30 degrees Celsius) to windy/rainy! Bring clothing for all types of weather for both you and your horse and the sun is bound to shine.

Cows and feral horses may be in the area. Usually they keep to themselves but please be aware, especially if you have a mare in season.

Dinner **may** be provided on Saturday night. Please check with ride management closer to the date. The camping area is part of a park. Dogs must be on leash at all times!
