**Directions/Location:** Mt. Adams Horse Camp, Trout Lake, WA – in the field adjacent to horse camp.  
***Do not come via FS23 through Randle, WA – this is not a horse trailer friendly route***

**From Oregon and I-84:**

- Take exit 64 to Hood River and head North
- Cross the toll bridge over the Columbia River – toward White Salmon, WA (passenger autos & pickups \$2.00 toll)
- Head West on Hwy 14 ~1mile
- Head North on Alt Hwy 141 ~4 miles
- Continue North on Hwy 141 ~20 miles to Trout Lake
- As you enter Trout Lake, bear right at the service station/cafe (Andy's)

Follow signs and ribbons to ride camp

**Alternates to Hood River bridge route:**

- From the East cross the bridge at The Dalles to Dallesport and travel West on the WA side of the river along Hwy 14 to Alt Hwy 141

From the West travel on Hwy 14 from Vancouver WA to Alt Hwy 141
