Directions: From Gooding, follow Highway 46 north to 1300 S (about six miles from town). Turn right and continue on 1300S for 6 miles to West County Rd., Lincoln/Gooding County Line Rd. Turn left and follow 3 miles of paved road and 6 miles of gravel road into camp.

Camp: Camp is on private land, please do not leave a mess! Horse water provided in camp and on all trails. All dogs in camp MUST be leashed!

Trail: Two-track and Jeep trails across the desert. Hoof protection is strongly recommended as there are rocky sections. Pads or boots are a great idea!

Ride Details: AERC ride with SWIT & DR, PNER and MRER regional points sanctioning. Vetting on Thursday evening once vets are on site with ride meeting at 6:30 pm. Fri/Sat/Sun dinner, awards and ride meeting each night. Potluck dinner each night with main course provided by ride management.

Entry Fees: All distances - \$110, trail ride \$20 (with dinner and award)
