We offer 3 glorious days of riding in the breathtaking mountains of the beautiful Boise Basin, where gold was discovered in 1862, and beautiful treasures are still found today.

Day 1 – Friday August 30th, 25 and 50 mile endurance rides Day 2 – Saturday August 31st, 25 and 55 mile endurance rides Day 3 – Sunday September 1st, 25, 50 and **100** mile endurance rides

## Trail rides and Introductory rides will be available all 3 days.

**Directions:** From I-84 in Boise take Hwy 21 NE 36 miles to Idaho City. Turn Left (north) onto Montgomery St. At the end of the street, turn left (west) and continue for 7 miles (dirt road between towns) to Centerville. Turn right (north) onto Henry's creek Rd. and continue approx. ½ mile into camp.

<u>Camp:</u> Ride camp is located on private property, but borders Forest Service land so **weed free hay is required.** Horse water will be supplied but bring people water. Dogs are always welcome but must be leashed at all times. GPS Coordinates: Latitude: 43.88627 Longitude: -115.90513

**FEE Schedule:** 25, 50 and 55 mile rides \$135 first day ridden, (additional days \$115) 100 Mile ride \$225. current year/reciprocating ride managers \$75 discount off (one day only; other days at full price). Intro Rides \$65 and Trail Rides \$35 per day. Non-AERC members will be subject to an additional \$20 per day non-member fee for competitive distances.

## JUNIORS (under age 18 as of 1/1/24) ride FREE

**<u>Start Times:</u>** 50 and 55 mile rides @ 7:00am; LDs @ 7:30am, 100 milers @ 5:30. Trail ride any time after 9am but no later than 3pm (trail riders must check in & out with ride management). Check-in and Vetting to start approx. 4pm on Thursday Aug 29<sup>th</sup> for Friday riders.

<u>Trails</u>: Trails are primarily old logging roads, ATV and single-track trials on private property, US Forest Service and Idaho State Lands. The terrain is mostly nice, sound footing with sandy surfaces, but there are water crossings and rocky sections through dredged creek banks. **Hoof Protection is** <u>STRONGLY</u> recommended for all horses.

Meetings: Registration starts approx. 4pm on Thursday. Pre-ride meeting at approx. 7pm.
