

NEW! **IDAHO IRONHORSE!**

Autumn Sun is the final leg in the Idaho Ironhorse competition. Proceeded by City of Rocks Pioneer and Top O The World Pioneer, these three days will cap an incredible competition for our riders and horses. See the website for additional information and standings!

Directions: From Gooding, follow Highway 46 north to 1300 S (about six miles from town). Turn right and continue on 1300S for 6 miles to West County Rd., Lincoln/Gooding County Line Rd. Turn left and follow 3 miles of paved road and 6 miles of gravel road into camp.

From Shoshone: take Highway 75 north for just over 8 miles. At milepost 82 turn left. This is Mammoth Cave Road. --Do NOT turn at the Mammoth Cave Scenic Attraction at milepost 81! Once on the gravel road, camp is about 10 miles in.

Camp: Camp is on private land, please do not leave a mess! Horse water provided in camp and on all trails. All dogs in camp MUST be leashed!

Trail: Two-track and Jeep trails across the desert. Hoof protection is strongly recommended as there are rocky sections. Pads or boots are a great idea!

Ride Details: AERC sanctioned ride with SWIT & DR, PNER and MRER regional points sanctioning. Vetting on Thursday evening once vets are on site with ride meeting at 6:30 pm. Fri/Sat/Sun dinner, awards and ride meeting each night. Potluck dinner each night with main course provided by ride management.

Cavalry Division: Please see website or contact us for full rules. There is no extra fee but riders must declare as Cavalry prior to the start each day.

Entry Fees: All distances - \$110 JUNIORS RIDE FREE!

Trail rides are \$20 and include completion award and dinner. Pre-registration is highly appreciated! You don't need to pre-pay, just let us know if you're coming so we can plan!
