## Directions to Ride Site and some information:

Ride camp address: 2964 E Barriere Lake Road, Barriere, BC VOE 1E0 (45 minutes north of Kamloops). Private property, no fees for camping.

Property is along the Barriere River, there is **no human** water but lots of water for horses. There are three areas. 1st tier at thetop of road will be vet in area, crewing area, some camping, start and finish are here. Second level will be for ride management and assistants,3<sup>rd</sup> level for rigs with corals and high tie etc.

To reach ride camp, which is approx 45 minutes north of Kamloops, follow signage to Barriere, come through town, (lots of stores and shops for your supplies including a feed store,) at South Barriere Lakes Road, (after the Legion and the bridge) turn right, follow 15 km, if you get to Ski Park you have gone too far, when you see signage for Kick Back Ranch, that is us. Turn right into driveway, left following drive way and follow Prison sign to lower areas if that is where your designated parking spot is.

There is no cell service or internet at ride site and no land line available. Pls advise anyone hoping to hear from you at home that you are out of the service area. There is land line that takes messages at 250 672-2040 in the event of an emergency contact requirement. Messages are gathered early morning and late evening only.

## About the trail:

These trails will leave the private property, along the road, to the logging roads that border South Barriere Lake and Johnson Lake. Water available from the lake all along the trail. Plan is to leave ride site, ride to the meadow and for the 25's and 50's loop out from meadow once for 25's, twice for 50's (different loops) and then back to ride camp. Out check will be at the meadow with hay and alfalfa provided there. Fun ride will be to the meadow and back to ride camp.

Vet Check will start at approx 3:30, Head Vet is Dr. Rob Mulligan, second vet: Dr. Stefanie Krumsiek and 3<sup>rd</sup> vet will be announced as required. The Equestrian Canada Technical Delegate is Joan Magee
